

Barts BioResource cumulative recruitment


Total consent N = 17547; Total re-consent N = 1204






Proportion of recruitment by researcher






Recruitment to each stratum






Completed blood collection out of all patients consented for blood






Completed tissue collection out of all patients consented for tissue






Location of patient recruitment






Location of patient recruitment






Recruitment trend of locations of consent


Recruitment trend of locations of consent MHS






Recruitment trend of locations of consent WHS






Consent for re-contact






Overall re-contact numbers






Consent for email contact out of all participants agreeing for re-contact






Proportion of patients consenting to future Contact via email Barts Health NHS Trust




June patients in the Cardiac Imaging Department





Cardiac Imaging Department June Out Of Hours






Ratio of data, blood donation and tissue collection






